PCRB CIRCULAR NO. 1810

To All Members of the PCRB:

Re: <u>APPROVAL OF PCRB FILING NO. 343</u> BASIC MANUAL HOUSEKEEPING REVISIONS TO SECTION 2 <u>EFFECTIVE APRIL 1, 2025</u>

The Pennsylvania Insurance Department has approved PCRB Filling No. 343 regarding housekeeping revisions to Section 2 of the Pennsylvania Workers' Compensation Manual of Rules, Classifications and Rating Values for Workers' Compensation and for Employer Liability Insurance (Basic Manual) for policies effective 12:01 a.m., April 1, 2025, or later. The effective date of these changes aligns with the effective date of the PCRB's normal annual comprehensive loss cost revision, which will be filed with the Insurance Department at a later date. This coordination will consolidate necessary changes that our members and other constituents must make to policies, forms, and systems.

The housekeeping revisions are intended to improve Basic Manual language by making it clearer and less ambiguous. The revisions clarify existing classification procedures and update language defining certain classifications in order to align with verbiage used in other Basic Manual revisions and/or to recognize ongoing technological or industrial changes. The revisions are intended to assist in the administration of the PCRB's uniform classification plan but do not revise the scope of any classification or impact any classification's PCRB loss cost value.

The Manual housekeeping revisions are summarized below:

Section 2

- Revisions to 6 classification descriptions for clarity.
- Underwriting Guide addition of 5 new entries, revision to 5 existing entries, and deletion of 1 entry.
- General Auditing & Classification Information Section revision to the "Temporary Staffing Contractor" entry for clarity.
